The County of San Saba has contracted with the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) to report instances of Failure to Appear (FTA) or Violate Promise to Appear (VPTA) within 10 business days required by the citation and all instances of a failure to pay any class c misdemeanor judgment and sentence. You may be denied renewal of your driver's license by the DPS should you fall to appear or pay your fine by order of the court.

JUSTICE COURT COURTESY LETTER

This letter is furnished as a courtesy to you by the Justice Courts of San Saba County to assist you in processing the charges filed against you.

1. PLEASE NOTE: The Judge cannot discuss the merits of a pending judicial proceeding prior to trial. (Cannon 3 (5), Code of Judicial Conduct).

This means the Judge cannot discuss your citation with you before the trial except for procedural questions.

- If you fail to respond to the charges by the appearance date shown on the citation, your fine may increase, an additional charge may be filed against you for <u>Violate Promise to Appear</u> with warrants issued for your arrest. (WARRANT FEES OF \$50.00 will be issues on each charge for EXECUTING OR PROCESSING A WARRANT.)
- 3. A JUVENILE who falls to appear by the time and date on a citation may have their license suspended as required by law (Transportation Code Section 729.001). (Juveniles <u>MUST</u> be accompanied by parent or legal guardian for ALL OFFENSES).
- 4. If you wish to enter a plea of NOT GUILTY or NOLO CONTENDERE, please indicate in the proper space provided. A plea of Nolo Contendere means that you do not contest the state's charges against you. The fine and conviction for a NOLO Contendere plea is the same as that for a plea of Guilty. Either plea indicates that you agree to waive appearance before the Court trial.

Refer to the schedule shown on the reverse side to determine the total amount of fines and costs acceptable by the Court. (These fines apply only to cases handled prior to court or judgment being entered.) RETURN A COPY OF THE CITATION AND THIS LETTER WITH YOUR REMITTANCE TO ASSURE PROPER CREDIT.

- 5. DRIVING SAFETY COURSE (CCP Art. 45.0511, Driving Safety Course or Motorcycle Operator Course Dismissal Procedures): (Holders of a CDL are NOT eligible for DSC.)
 - a. You may be able to have this charge dismissed by successfully completing a driving safety course or a motorcycle operating training course. You will lose that right if, on or before your appearance date, you do not provide the court with notice of your request to take the course.
 - b. A CHARGE MAY BE DISMISSED BY COMPLETING A DRIVING SAFTEY COURSE IF:
 - 1. You submit your application for the Driving Safety Course and it is approved by the Court.
 - 2. You are charged with a moving traffic violation other that 25 mph or more above the posted speed limit, or a speed of 95 mph or higher, passing a school bus, construction zone violations with workers present, or certain offenses involving traffic accidents;
 - 3. You have not completed an approved driving safety course in the state or another state during the 12 months immediately preceding the date of your ticket.
 - 4. You have a valid Texas driver's license other than a Commercial Driver License and you provide the court a copy.
 - 5. You provide the court with proof of liability insurance that complies with state law.
 - 6. You pay the court costs of the ticket (146.00) in the form of a cashier's check or money order made out to Justice Court San Saba.
 - 7. After the court receives items requested in lines #1, #4, #5, and #6, due on or before your appearance date written on your ticket, you will be given 90 days to complete the following:
 - a. Obtain a copy of your driving record. You may do this online at www.texas.gov with a credit card or completing the DPS form (available at www.txdps.state.tx.us) by following the instructions written on the form.
 - b. Complete a Driving Safety Course that is approved by the state.
