Failure to Attend School

Failure to Pay the Fine or to Comply with the Additional Orders Imposed in the Judgment

A defendant who fails to satisfy the fine and court cost as directed by the court may be held in contempt of if the defendant is under 17 years of age, may be referred to the San Saba County Juvenile Probation for violating the court's Orders. A defendant held in contempt may be punished by either or both of the following:

1. A fine not to exceed \$500.00
2. The suspension of the defendant's driver license until the defendant fully complies with the orders of the court, or the denial of the issuance of a driver's license to the defendant until the defendant fully complies with the Orders of the court.

If a defendant fails to satisfy the judgment for fine and costs as required by the court, the court may issue a Capias Pro Fine ordering the arrest of the defendant to be brought before the court. A Capias Pro Fine may issue at the time the defendant is 17 years of age or older.
