Order Lifting Burn Ban
July 17, 2026

WHEREAS, the San Saba County Commissioners Court determined on July 6, 2026 that circumstances presented in all or part of the unincorporated area of the County created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and

WHEREAS, the San Saba County Commissioners Court adopted an order instituting a burn ban effective on July 6, 2026 and

WHEREAS, the County Judge has the authority to lift the Burn Ban Order if he deems conditions warrant such; and

WHEREAS, the County has received beneficial moisture and ground saturation due to the rain that affected all of San Saba County on July 15 and 16, 2026 and there are improved weather conditions since the adoption of the Burn Ban Order; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge finds the circumstances present at the Commissioners Court meeting of July 6, 2026, no longer exist in such a manner that creates a public safety hazard by outdoor burning;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jody Fauley, County Judge do hereby lift the Order adopted on July 6, 2026 by the San Saba County Commissioners Court restricting Outdoor Burning. This Temporary Order lifting the ban on outdoor burning shall take effect immediately and will expire at noon, 12:00 PM, on July 20, 2026.
