## **DISASTER DECLARATION**

**For**

**San Saba County, Texas**

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Saba, on the 4th day of July 2025, has anticipated to suffer widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and there continues the imminent threat of same resulting from heavy, continuous rains and thunderstorms causing flooding and road failures, and;

**WHEREAS**, the judge of the County of San Saba, with unanimous support of the San Saba County Commissioner's Court, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SAN SABA COUNTY that:**


- 1) A local state of disaster is hereby proclaimed for San Saba County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code; and
- 2) Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued/ renewed by the Commissioners Court of San Saba County.
- 3) Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of San Saba County.


- 4) Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration of the local state of disaster activates the San Saba County Emergency Management Plan.


This Declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.


